Healthy Snacks for the Westie Baker in You! *Peanut Butter Doggie Bones – Only 4 Ingredients*

These are amazing – a healthy alternative your westie will love

Ingredients:

- 2 cups whole-wheat flour (our use Gluten Free Baking Flour for those Westies with Allergies)
- 1 Tablespoon baking powder
- 1 cup natural peanut butter
- 1 cup low-fat milk



Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a bowl, combine flour and baking powder. In another bowl, mix peanut butter and milk. Add wet mixture to dry, and mix well. Turn out dough on a lightly floured surface and knead. Roll out to 1/4-inch thickness and cut out shapes. Place on a greased baking sheet and bake 20 minutes or until lightly brown. Cool on a rack and store in an airtight container.
